Attendance at a portfolio information session is required prior to a student's last semester, and students are only eligible to submit their portfolios during their final semester. Further, portfolios are only evaluated during Fall and Spring semesters. Students taking their final course(s) in the summer are required to enroll in the subsequent fall semester in order to submit their portfolio.*

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
